United Nations General Assembly to hold Non-Communicable Disease Summit in 2011

For the first time ever, the United Nations General Assembly will hold a Non-Communicable Disease (NCD) Summit involving Heads of State in September 2011. The Summit will address the threat posed by NCDs to low- and middle-income countries. The UN General Assembly decision was congratulated by the World Heart Federation, International Diabetes Federation, International Union Against Cancer, and the International Union Against Tuberculosis and Lung Diseases. This alliance of nongovernmental organizations (NGOs) represents the four diseases—cardiovascular disease, diabetes, cancer and chronic respiratory diseases—that are responsible for 35 million annual deaths globally, 80% of which occur in LMICs. The NCD Alliance has been at the forefront of advocacy efforts to ensure the rising burden of NCDs was addressed in the global health and development agendas.
